E is for **energetic**, which my grandma has to be.



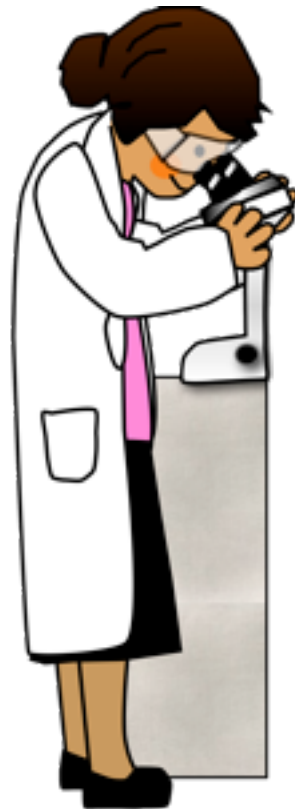
Whenever grandma is around, she tries to keep up with me!

P is for **purposeful**, she knows what to say and do.



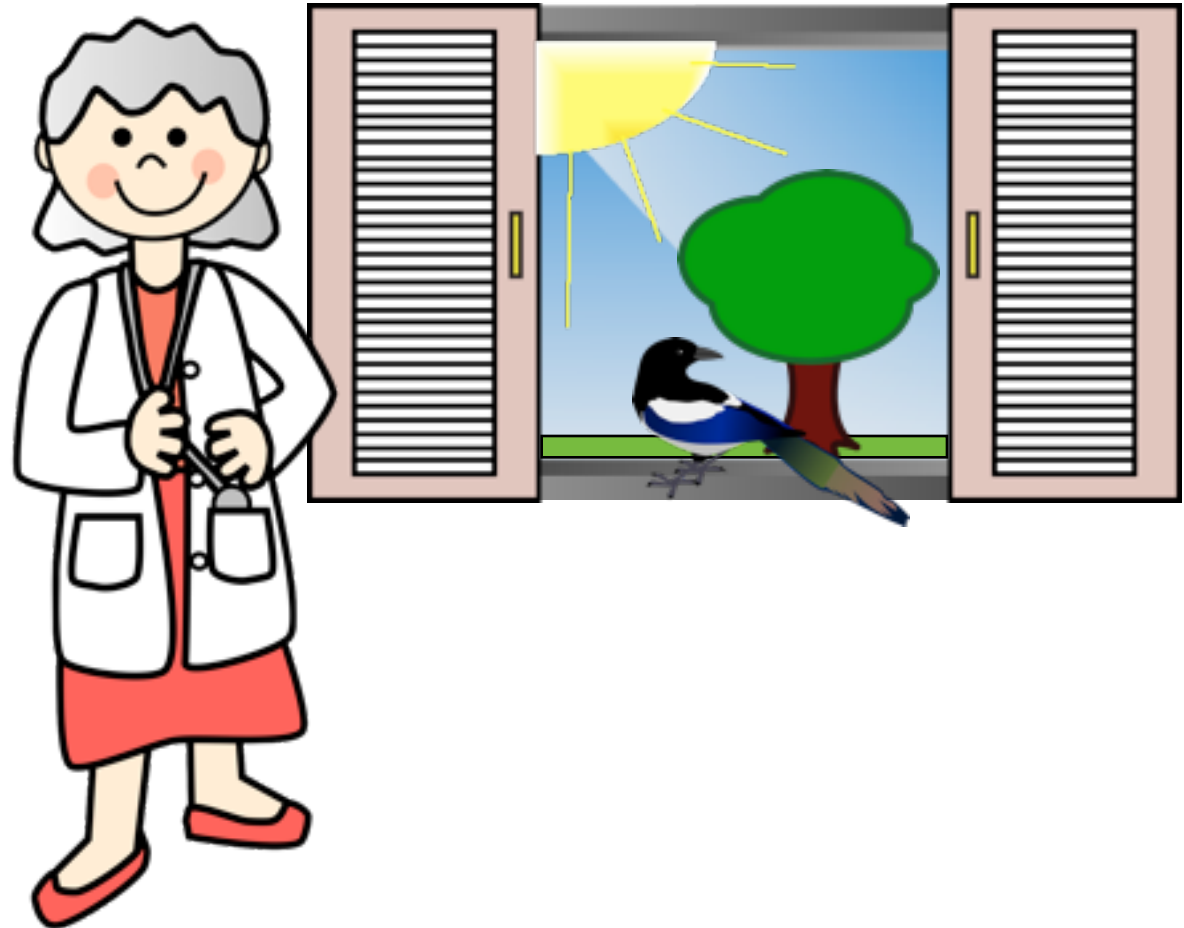
Q is for **quiet**; sssshhh - you know it's true.

R is for **resourceful**, grandma knows just where to shop.



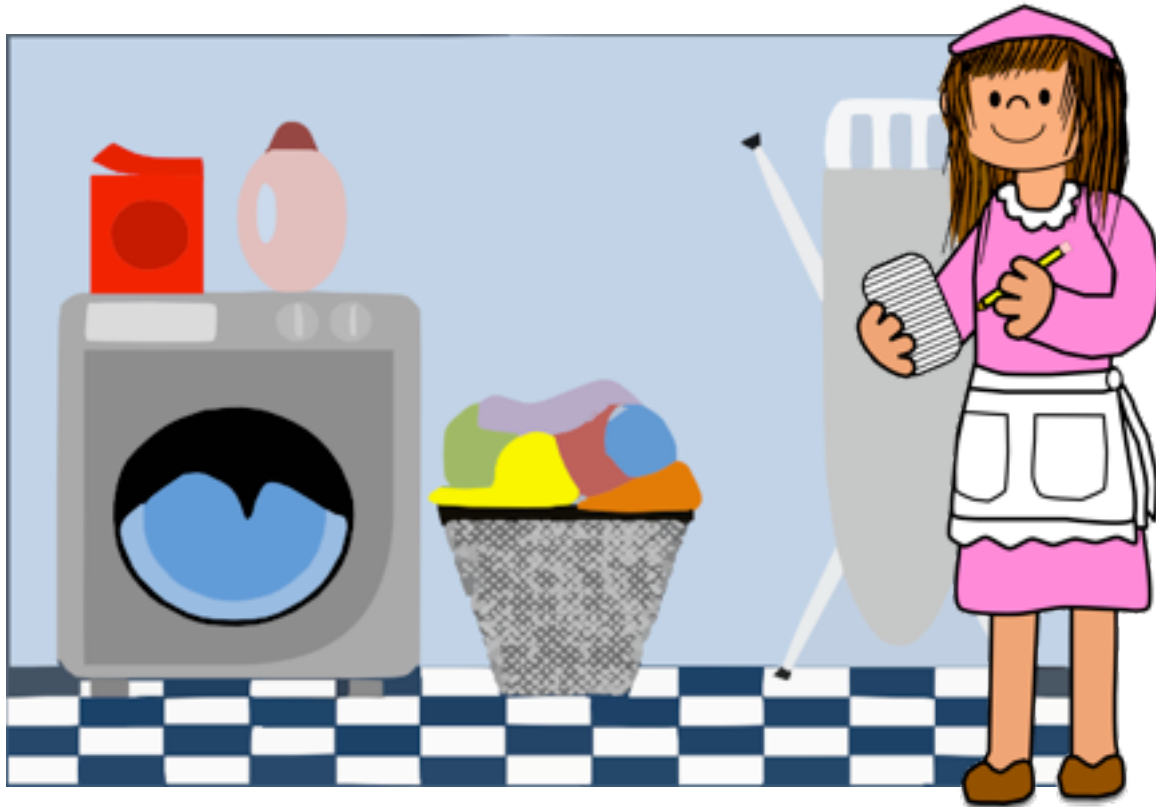
S is for **saving** because she knows just when to stop.
