Counting shamrocks is intended to have the numbers printed on the back of the shamrocks. The numbered cards can them be placed unto the remaining 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" numbered sheet as part of a matching numbers game.


The final sheet is intended to be used as an easy way to create St. Patrick's Day cards with your little one. Enjoy!






Cutting Practice

Grown-up: help child cut out along dotted line. Discuss shapes.




Matching Shapes

Parent: Cut into strips



Count Shamrocks


You can print either the solid or dotted-line numbers on the back of the shamrocks & match to card.
