
Puzzle Crafts


<u>Directions</u>: Print, laminate and cut out puzzle pieces. To assist child, you may want to print an additional page as a guide.


Activities: Grown-ups can help the child assemble the puzzles.


Talk about the colors you see. Help your child piece together like colors, patterns and more.

Have fun creating these puzzles with your little-one(s).






