For our lesson materials I use a [Board Dudes 18" x 22" Magnetic Dry Erase Board](#).

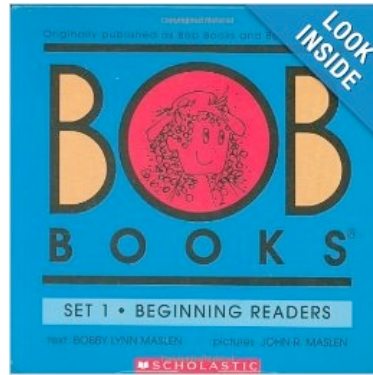

Puzzle Crafts

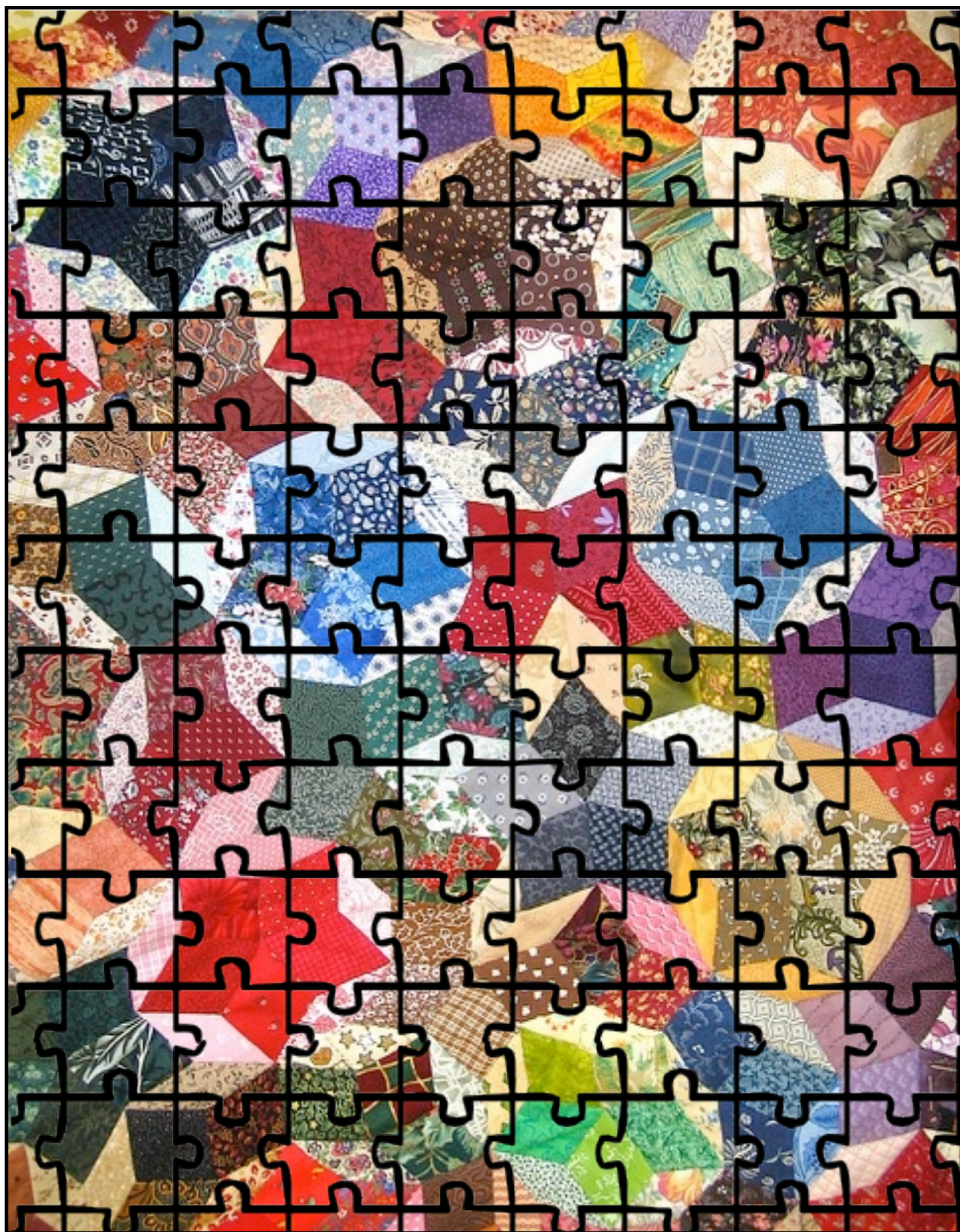
Directions: Print, laminate and cut out puzzle pieces. To assist child, you may want to print an additional page as a guide.

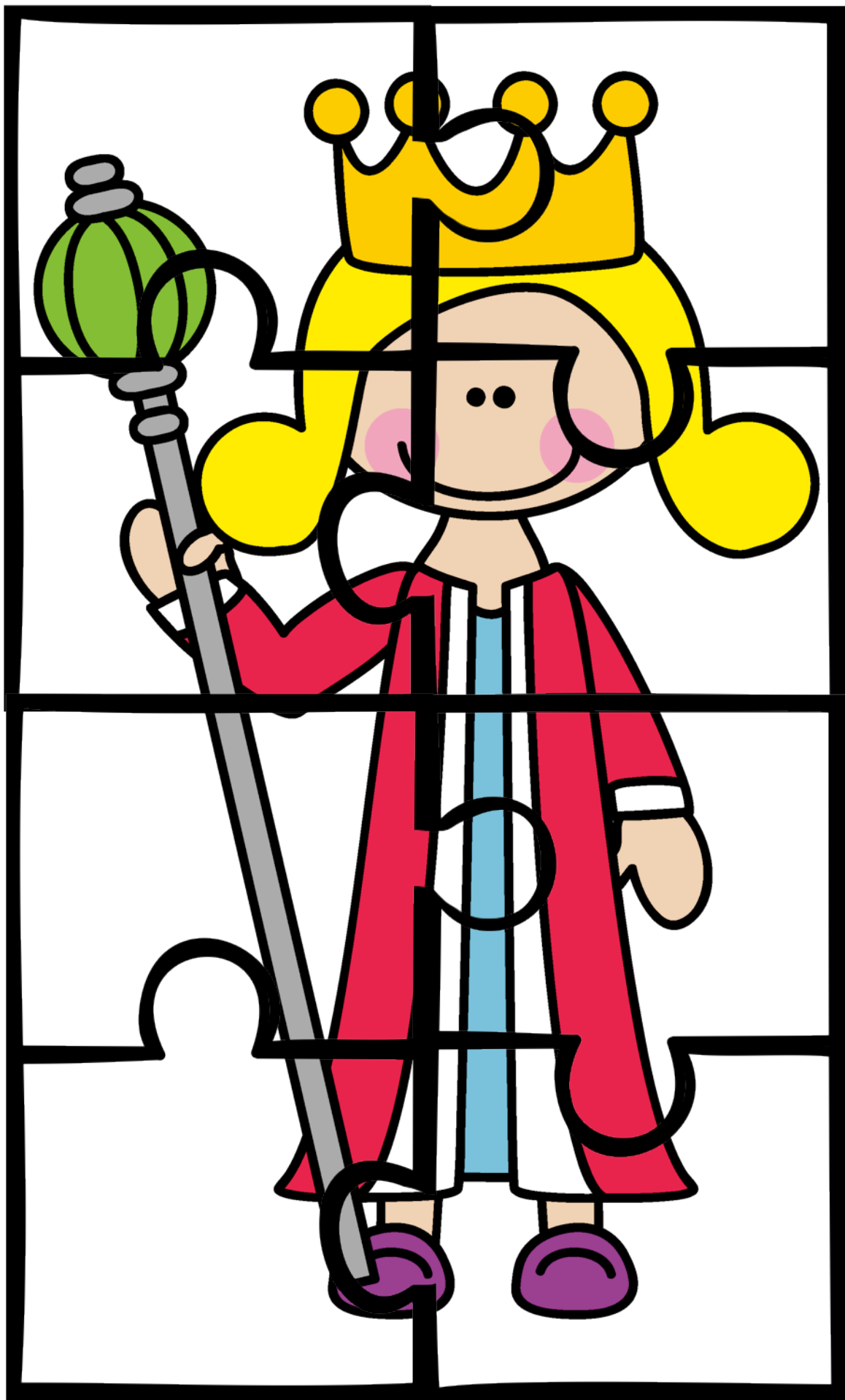
Activities: Grown-ups can help the child assemble the puzzles.

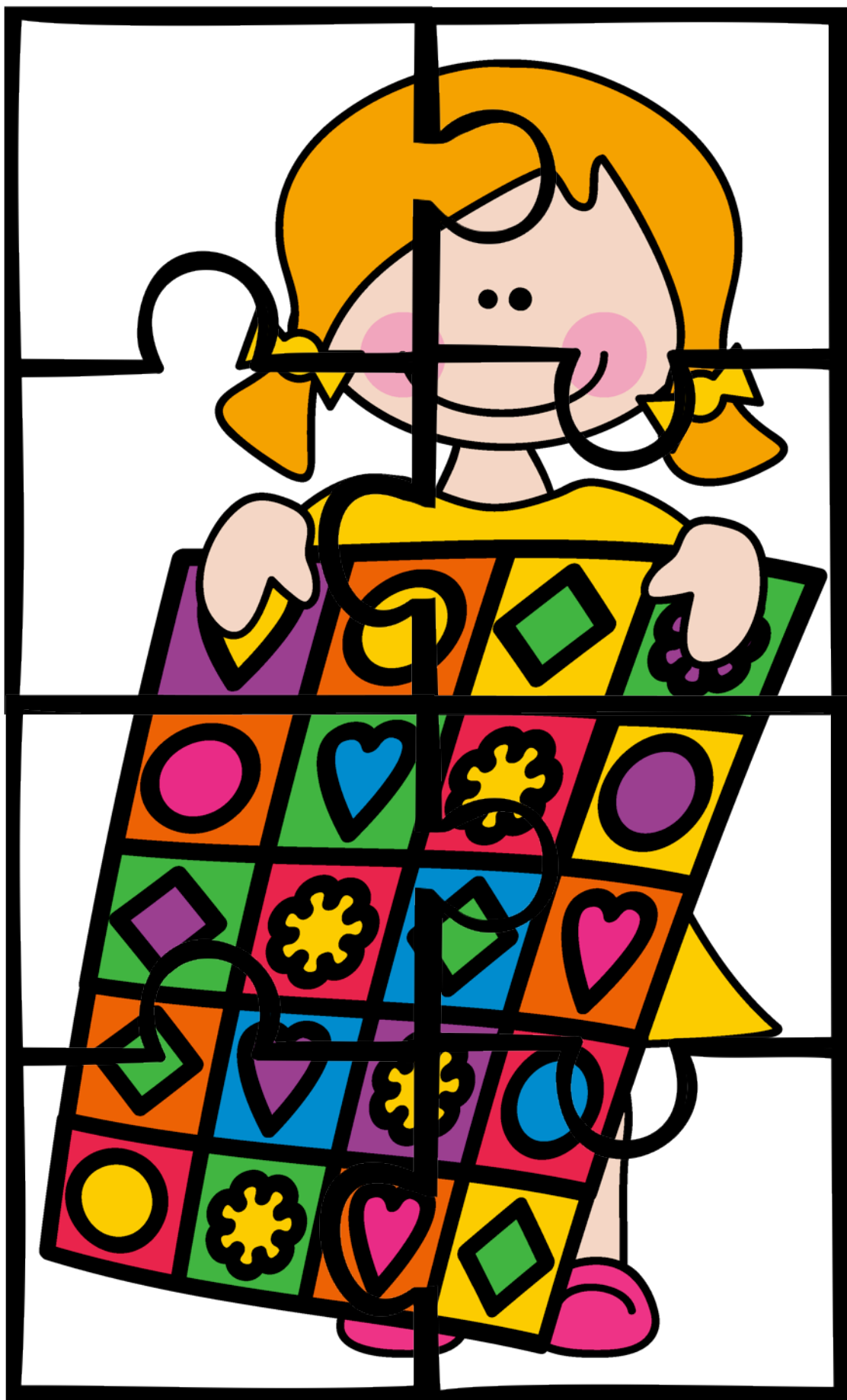
Talk about the colors you see. Help your child piece together like colors, patterns and more.

Special Note: The quilt puzzle is considerably more advanced. You may or may not be able to complete this puzzle with your child. Simpler puzzles are also included.







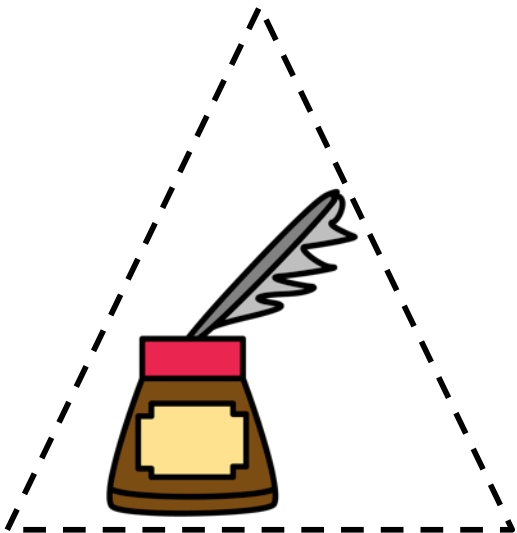
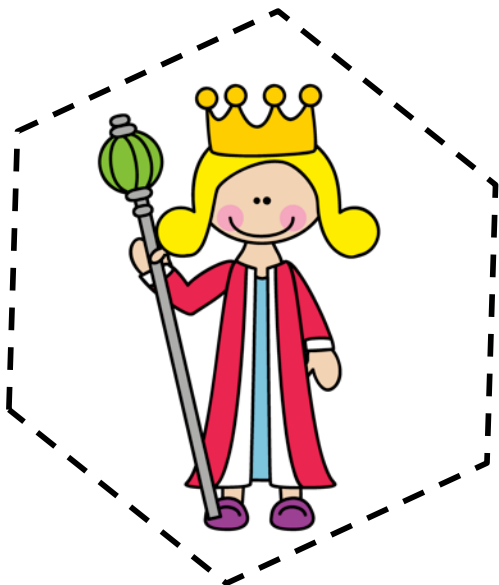
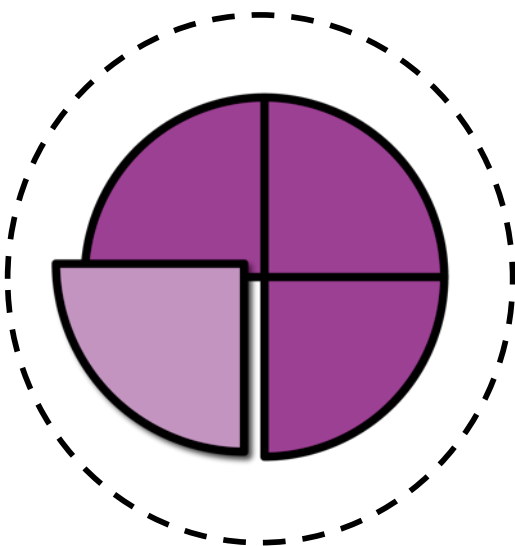
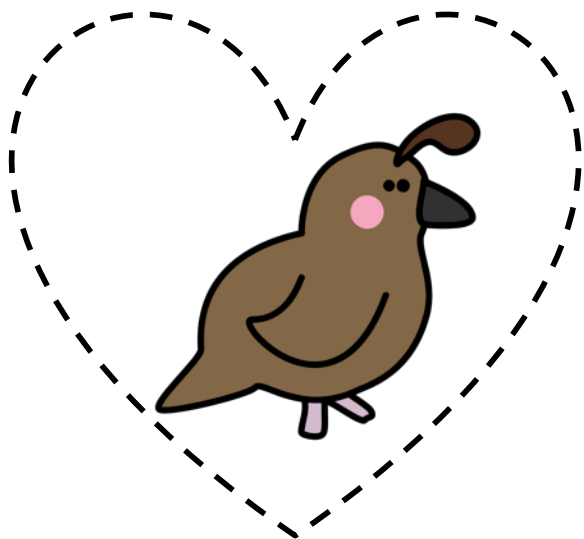
Quail Lace-Up

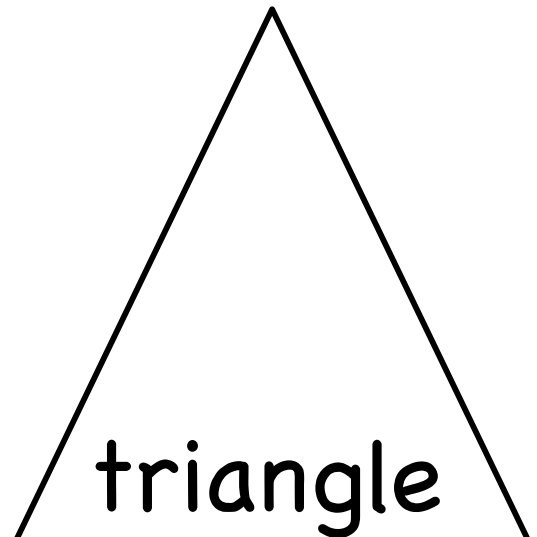
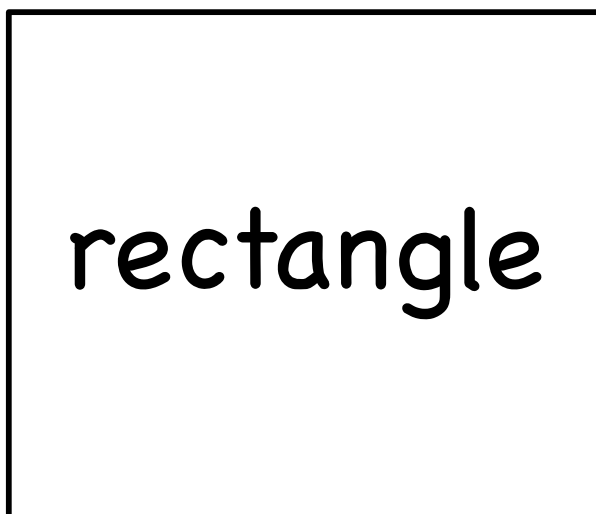
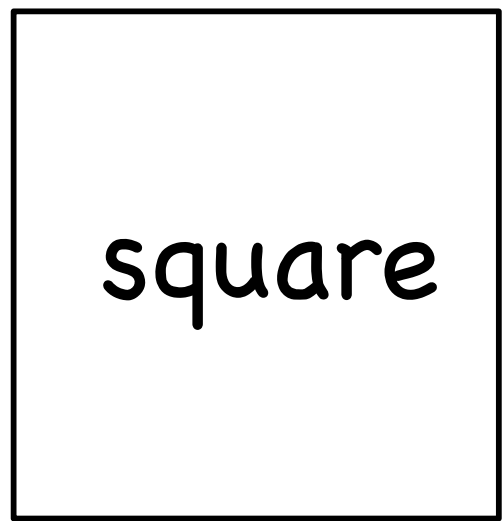
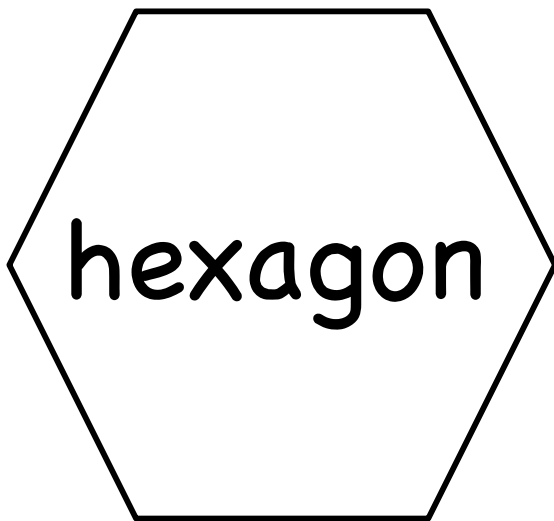
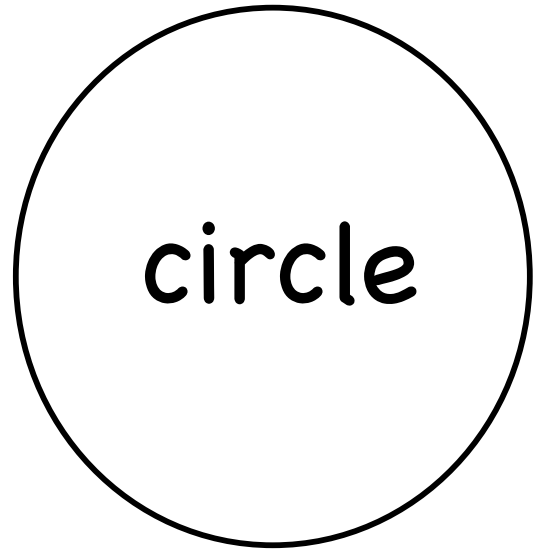
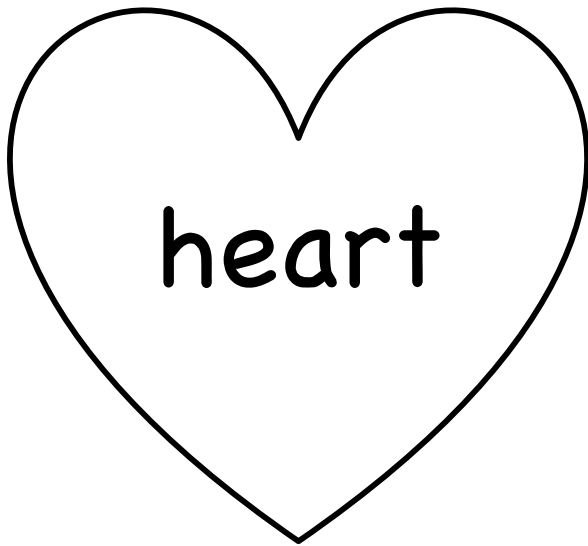
Cutting Practice

Grown-up: help child cut out along dotted line. Discuss shapes.



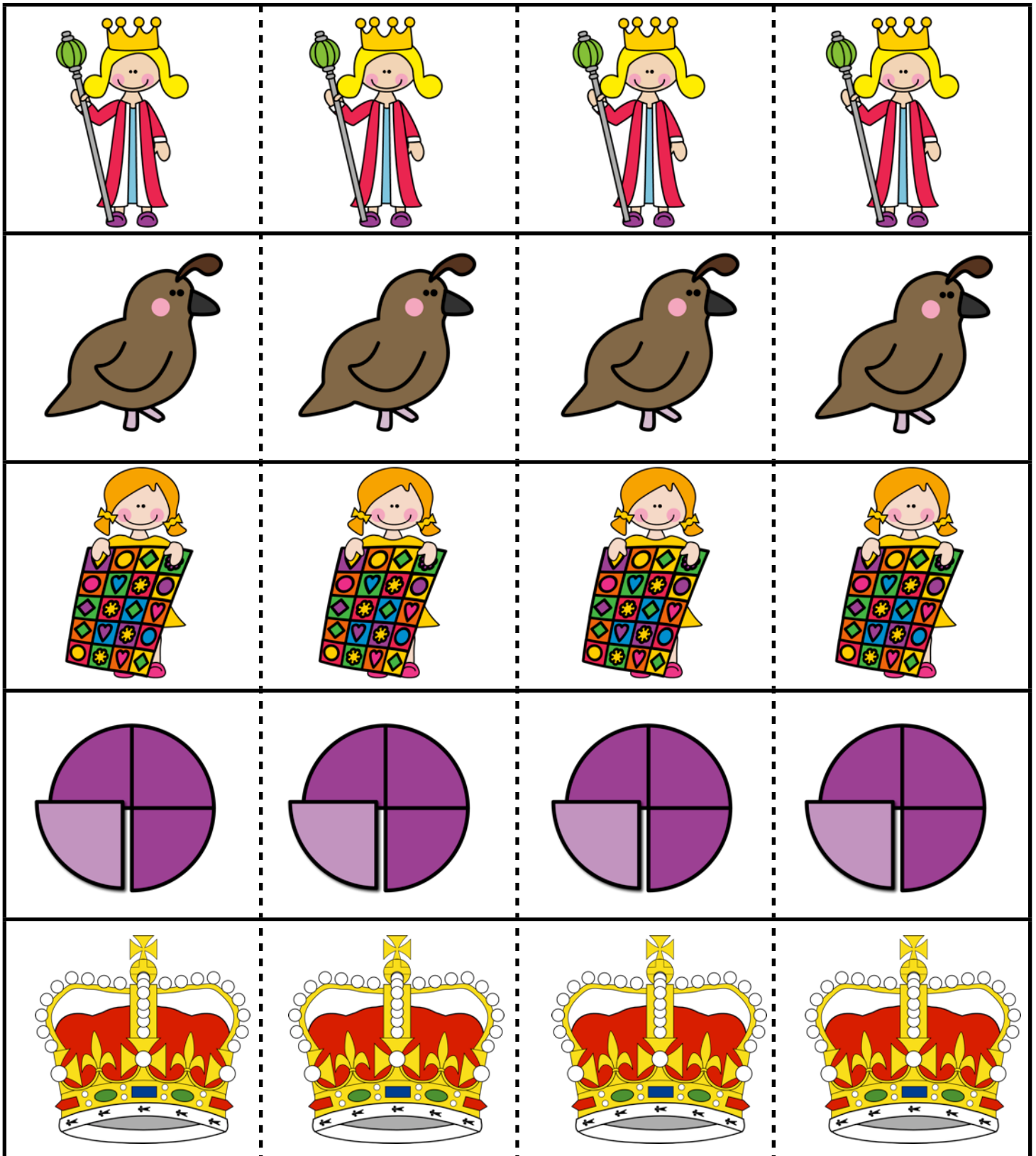
Cutting Practice

Point out qualities of various shapes. Cut out and align.






Have child cut along dotted lines.

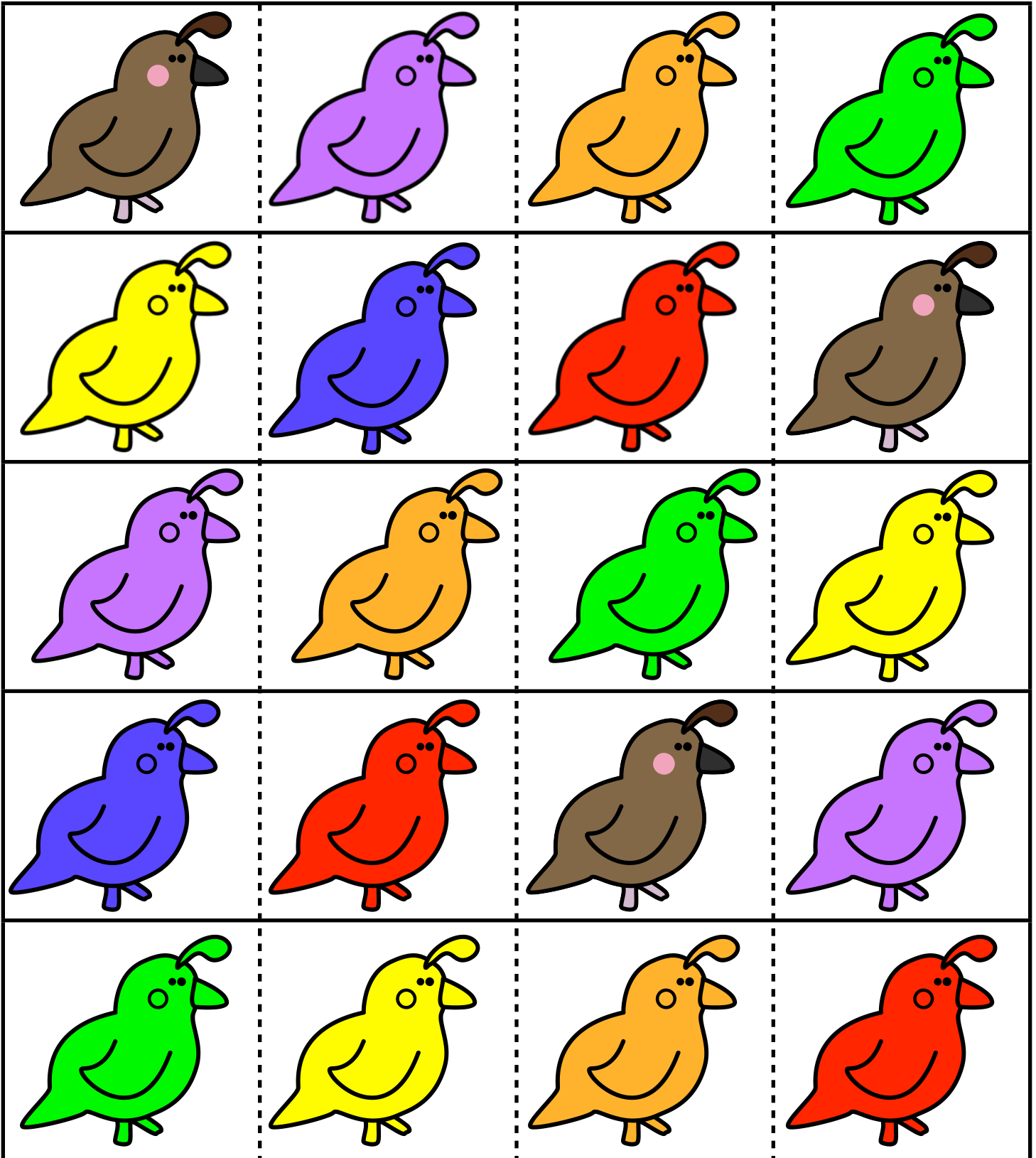

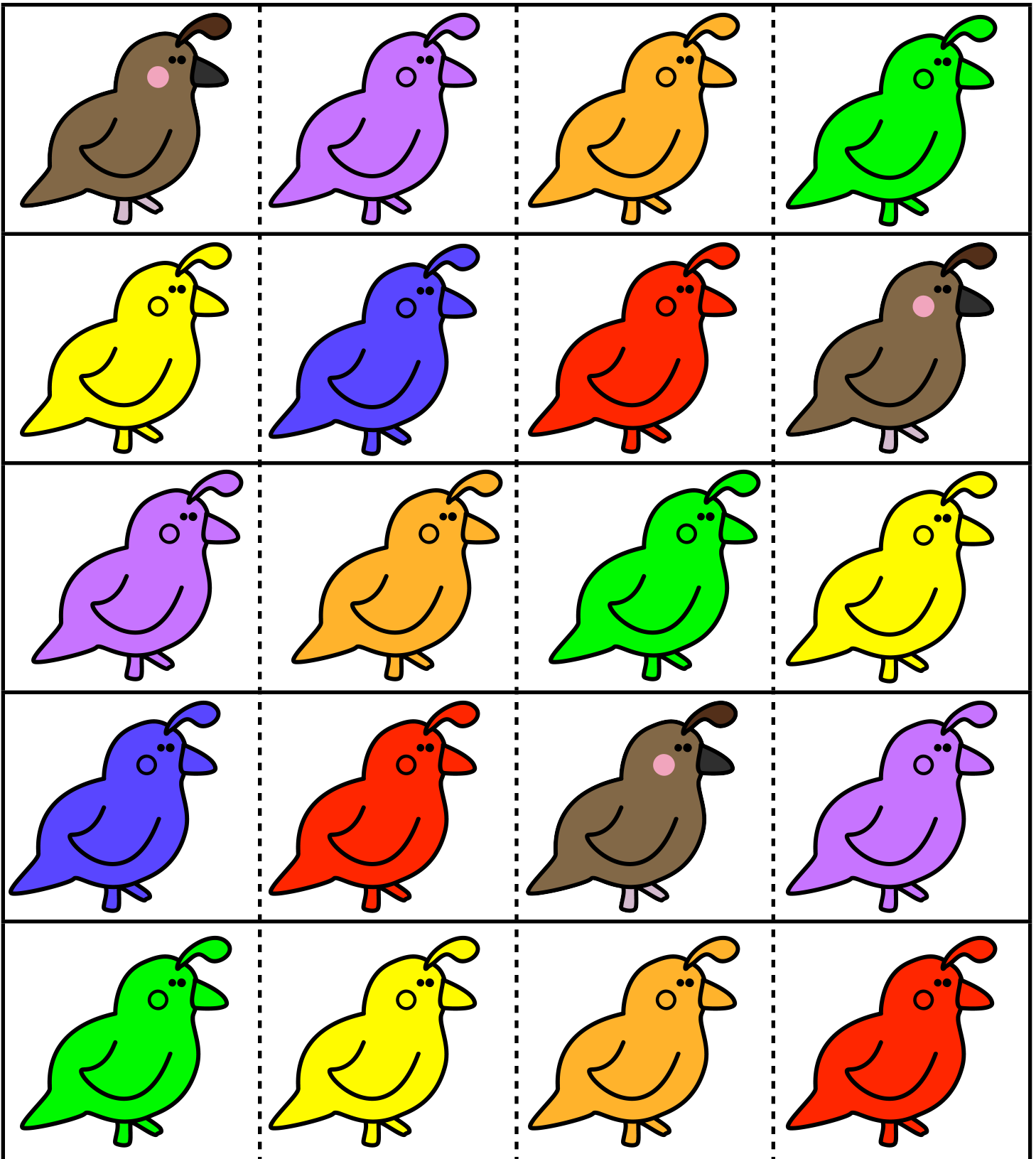

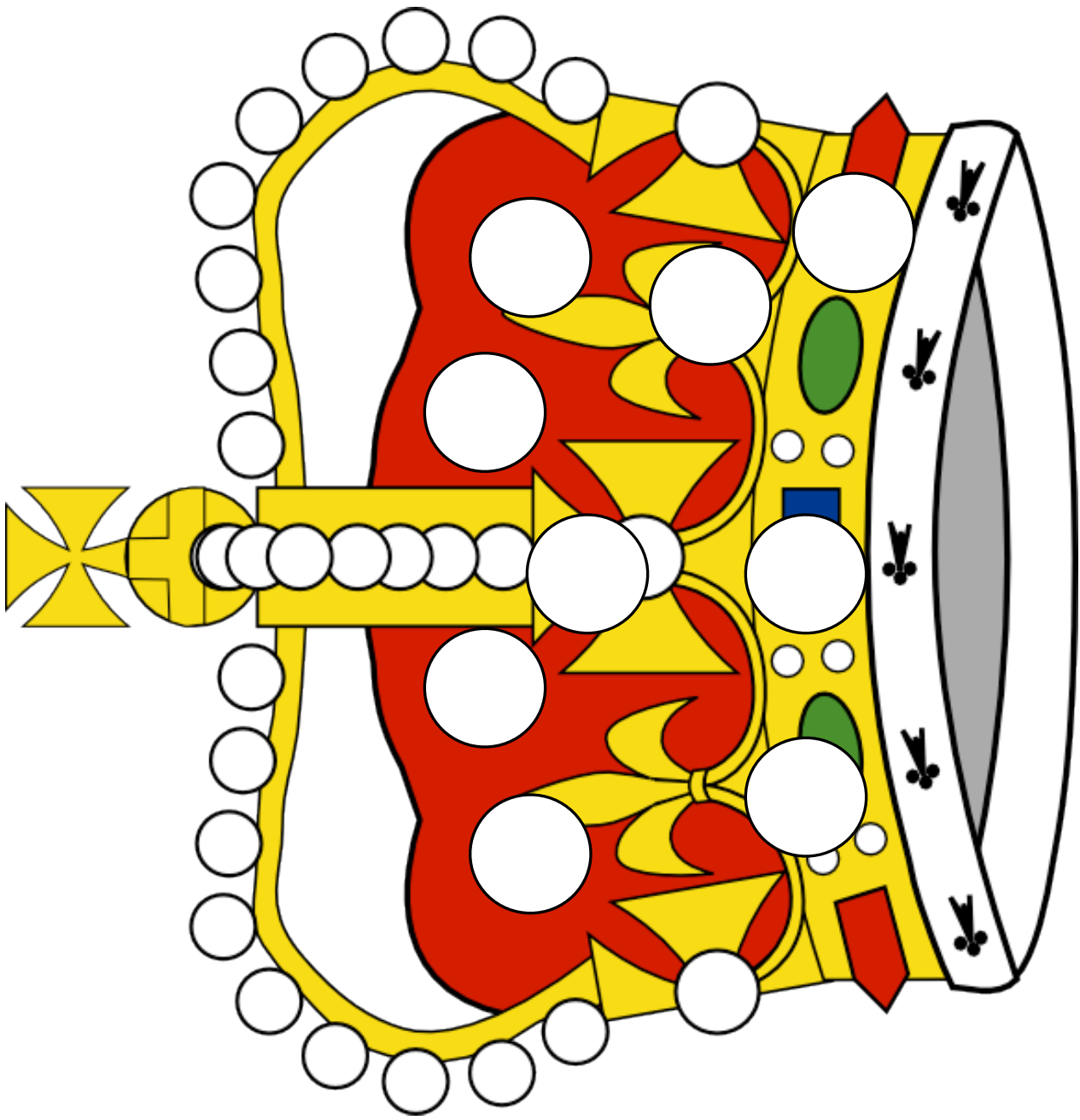
Count and place quail in the tree or surrounding area. Talk about how quail build nests and can fly.
You can play math games with the quail by adding and subtracting quail.



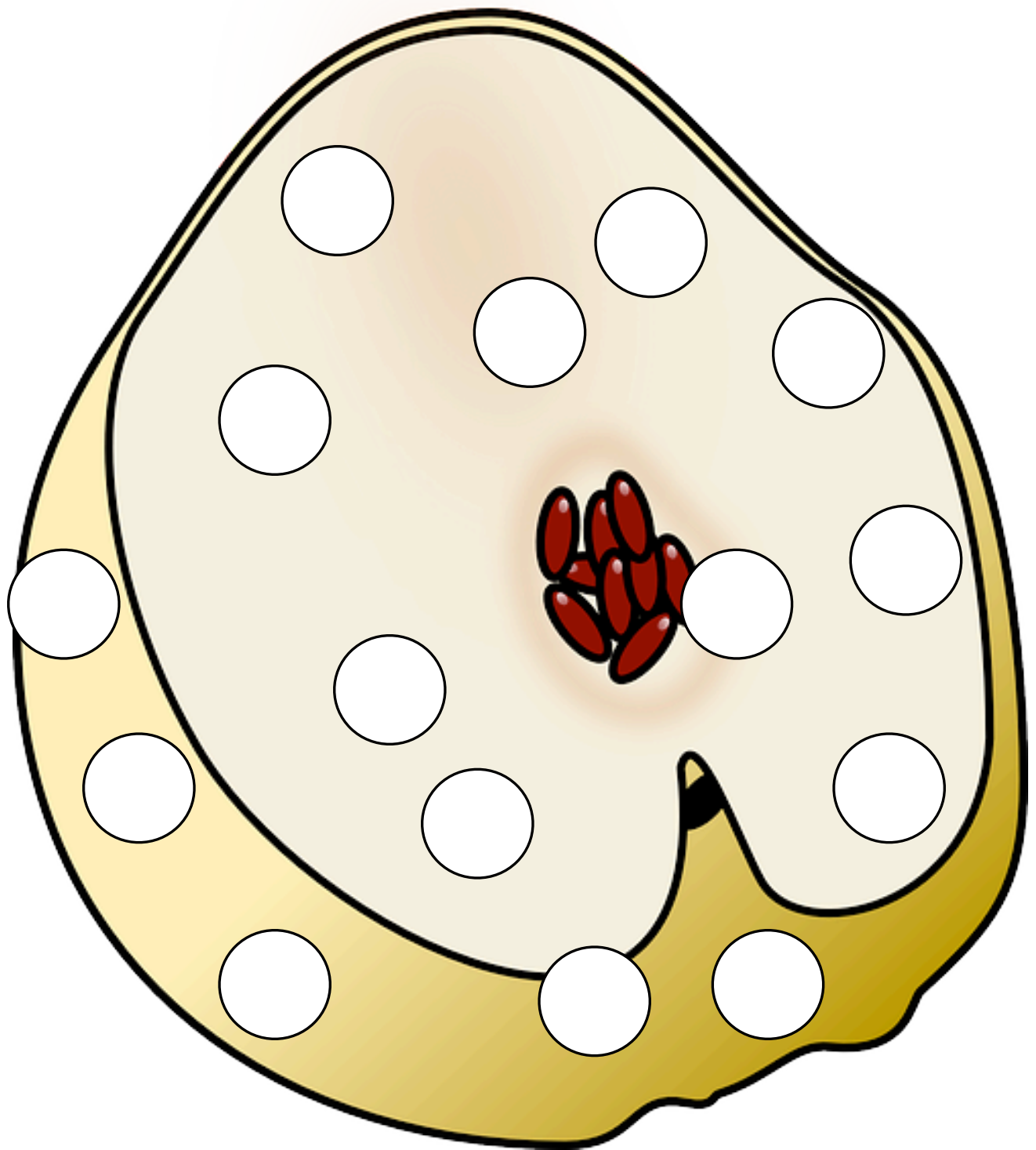
