Activities: Grown-ups can write in the text for the fill-inthe blanks, or if the child is old enough, he or she can write in the fill-in-the-blanks.

Use yarn, string, pom-poms or other "furry" embellishment for the hair. You can add "google" eyes for the eyes. Use puffy paint, finger-paints, colored sand, or other art supplies to add texture.

You can "frame" the final product by gluing it on top of construction paper. You can also opt to hole-punch the pages and place them into a binder, or have them spiral bound at an office supply store.






