


### Bee Easy Craft

Print this bee on yellow construction paper and cut into four pieces. You will have a head, body and two wings. Have your child try to put the bee back together like a puzzle on another piece of construction paper. You can also remove the antenna and provide pipe cleaners. For even more dimension add puffy paint, glitter glue or pom-poms to this craft.


## Letter "B" Hop-to or Wall ID


- 1. Laminate and cut the oval shaped cards.
- 2. These can be hung on the wall or taped to the floor.
- 3. Review the flashcards with your child.
- 4. Place the cards on a table in a stack. Draw from the stack (or have the child draw from the stack) and ask your child to tell you which image or word goes with each matching card.
- 5. The child has to touch the card that matches either by standing on it or by touching it on the wall. You can also have them stick a flashcard on the oval picture that matches the card.
- 6. You can match the images to the images, or for greater difficulty show them the card with a word on it and ask them to read the card.
- 7. Variation can include a "twister" type version where you ask the child to touch a card with his right foot, then the next card with his left foot and so on.




























## Letter "B" Bees Game


- 1. Laminate the bee hive and bees. Cut out the bees.
- 2. For use as a word game, review the flashcards with your child.
- 3. Hang the bee hive. You can add the bees to the hive or ask the child to do so as he/or she recognizes and says the word on each bee.
- 4. Stack the flashcards in a pile. The child can either get a bee right by matching the words or the word to the picture.
- 5. For every bee guessed correctly, the child gets a bee (see pages). If playing with more than one player the child with the most bees wins. Play through all the cards at least once.
- 6. You can also use the bees for counting and or easy math such as addition or subtraction.
- 7. Reward player(s) with honey on a cracker at the end of the game.




You can also use this as a counting activity. Ask your child how many bees are near the hive. Use the bees for basic addition and subtraction. If you print these bees on an  $8\,\%$ " x 11" white or clear shipping label you can use them as stickers.








