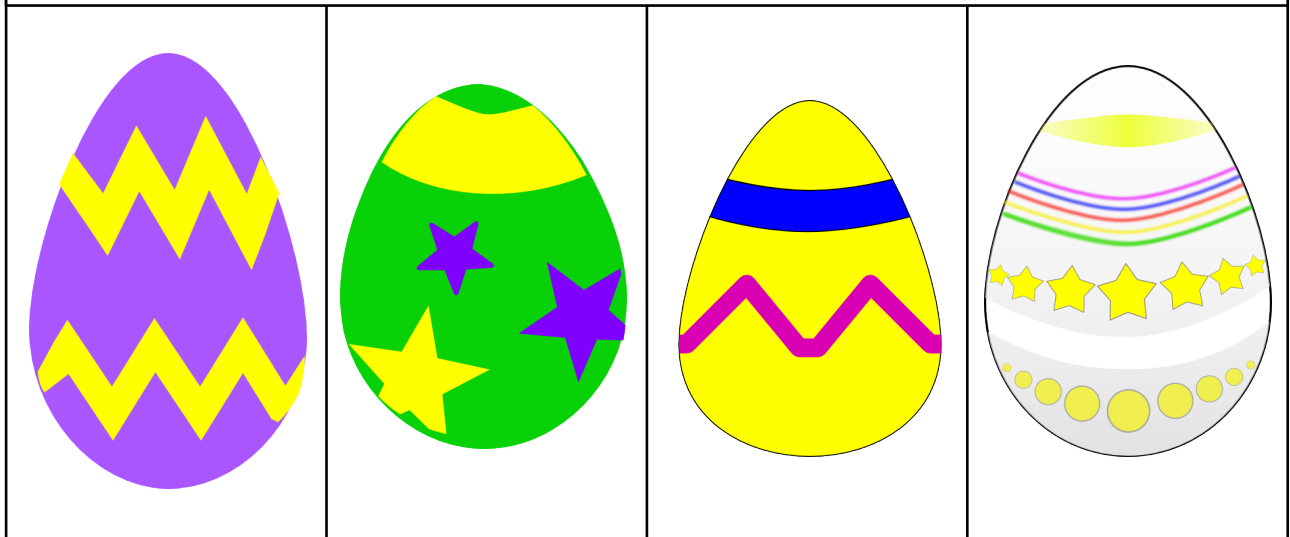
Eat Puzzle

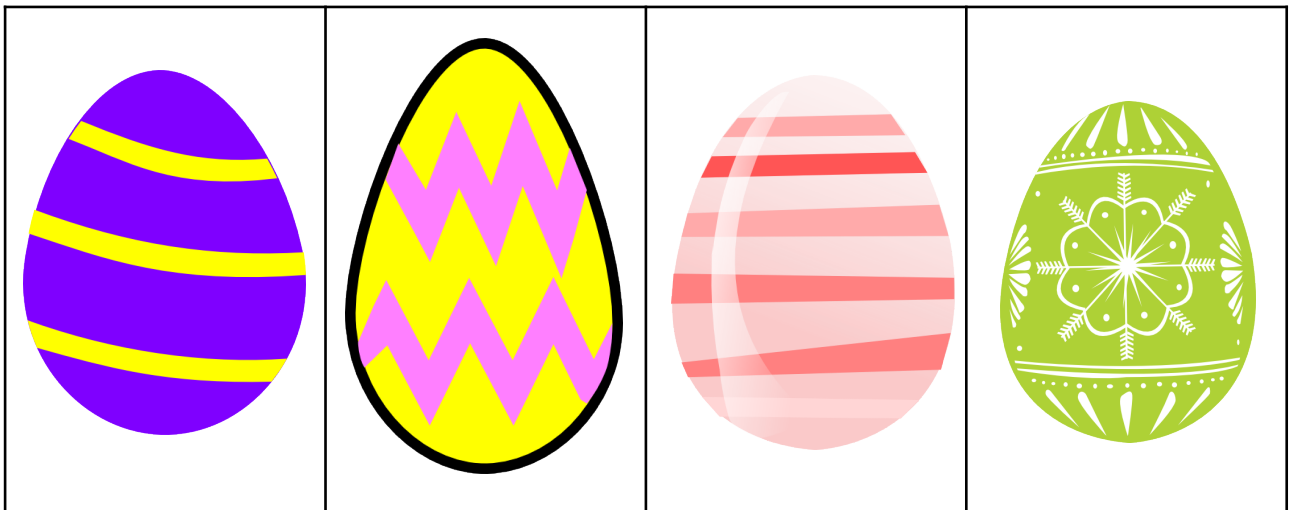
Print onto heavy card stock. You can laminate for extra durability. Cut along jigsaw lines and encourage your child to piece the puzzle together.



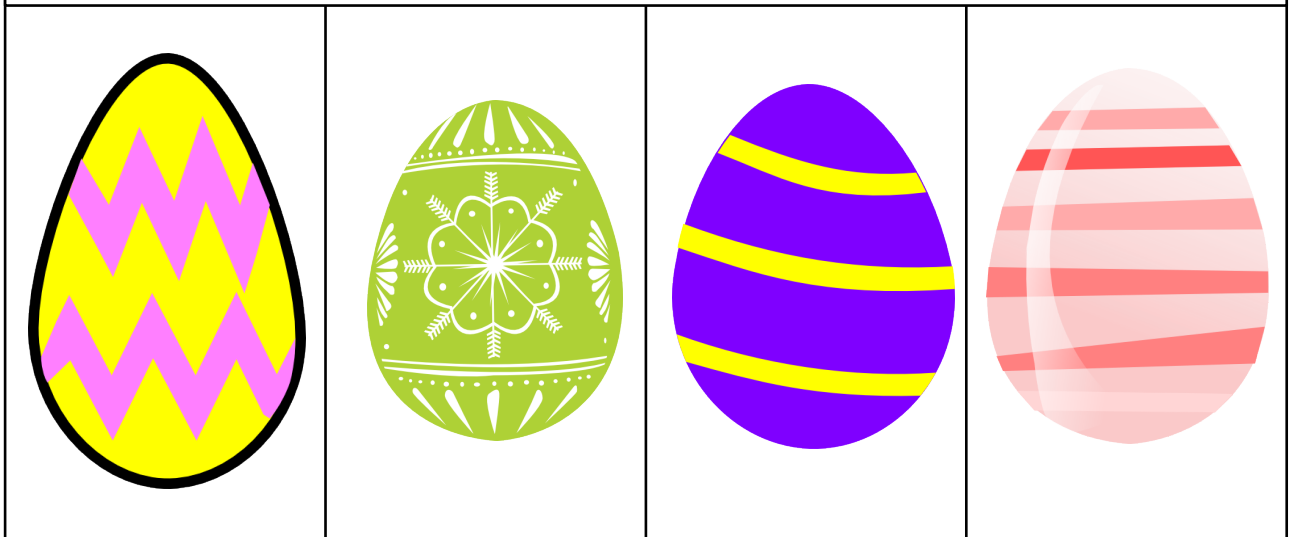

Elf Craft

Print the B/W elf on white cardstock or print several copies on different colored pieces of construction paper. Cut apart each Part of the elf (hat, head, body, legs, shoes) and see if your child can piece it back together like a puzzle. You can also number the pieces to help your child identify which piece comes next. You can use google eyes for the eyes, markers, paint, puffy paint, and/or glitter to decorate.

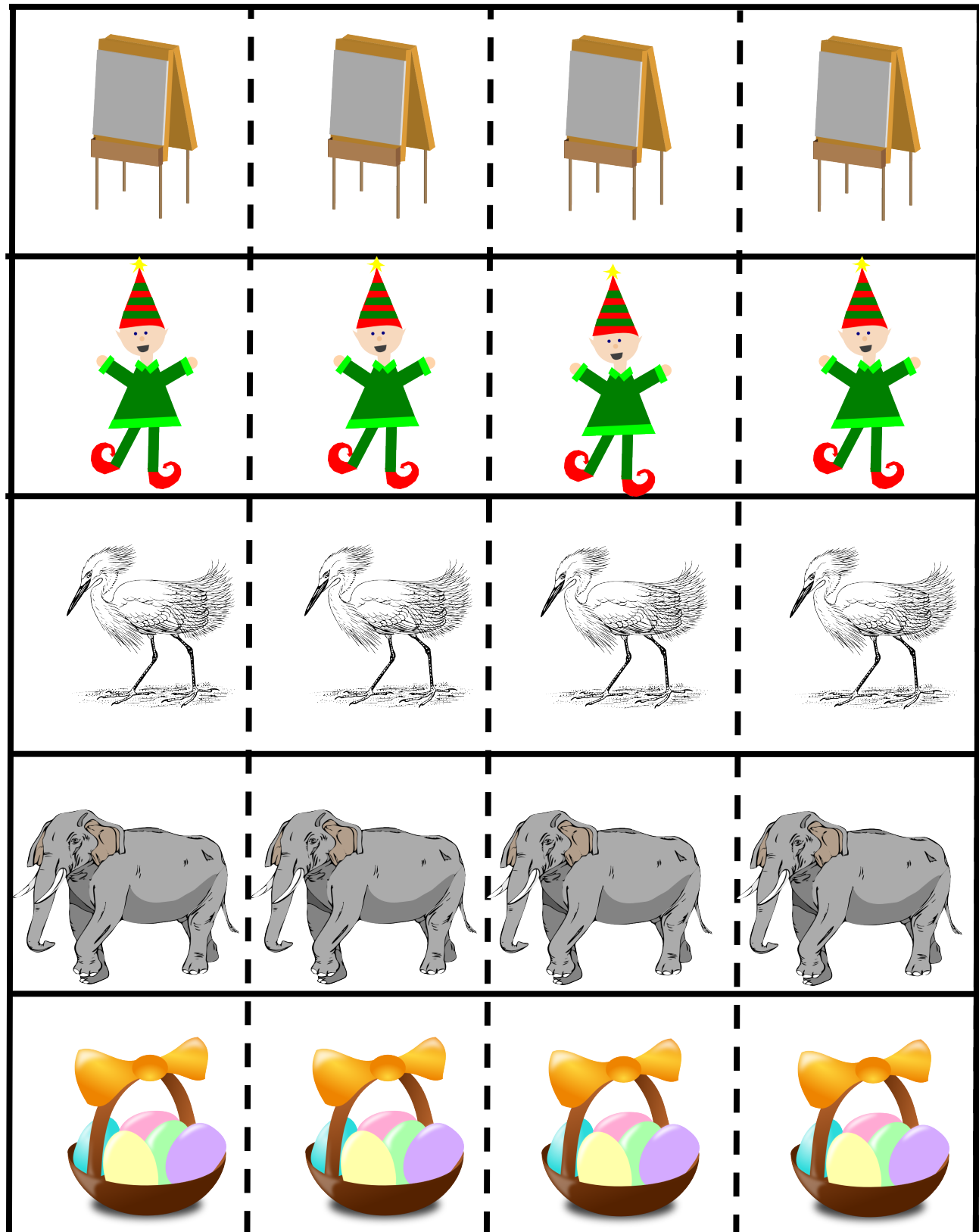
Earth Lace-up

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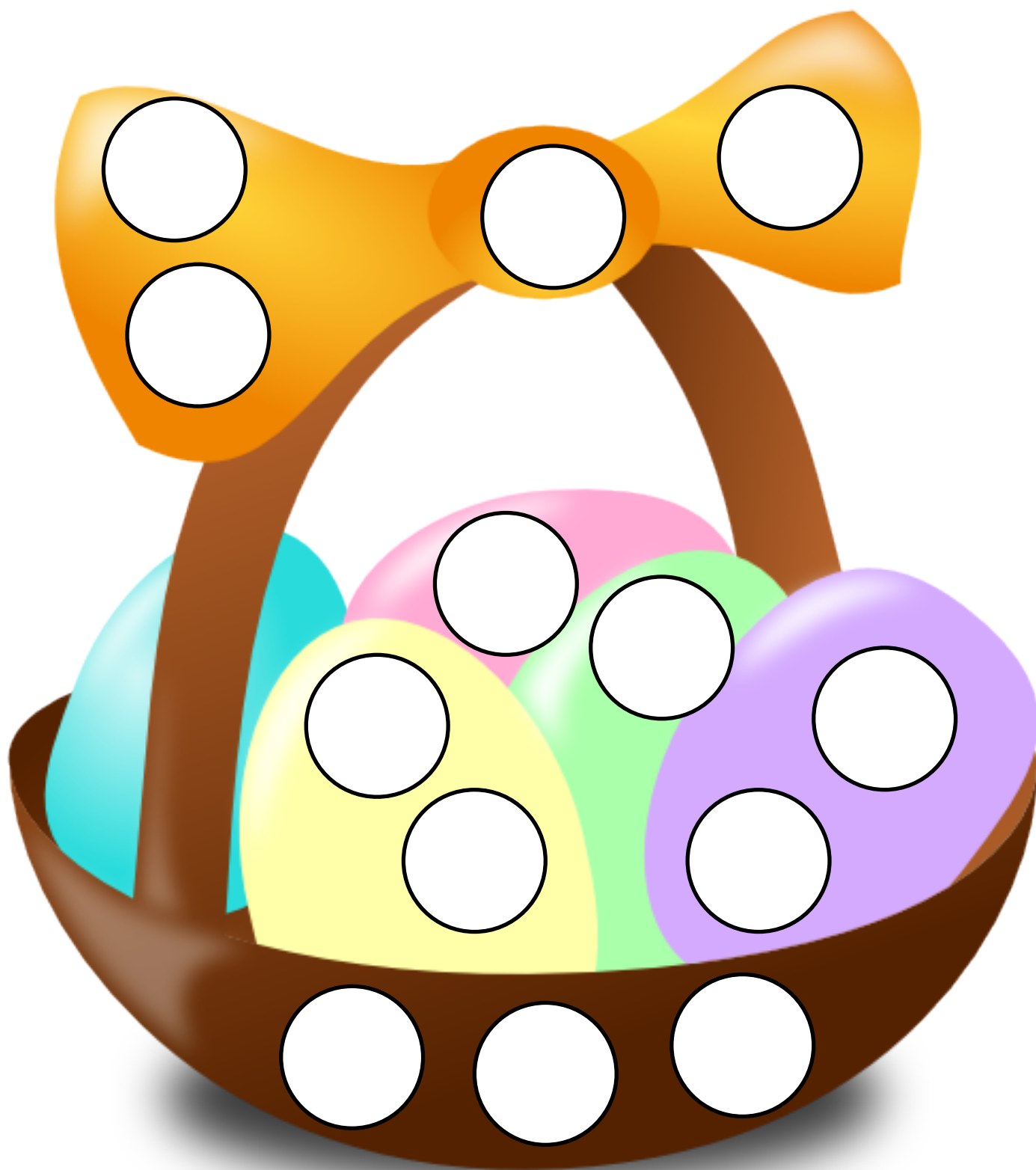
This is a great activity to complete with do-a-dot paints. You can also provide your child with stickers, pom-poms or some other small object to fill in the white circles.



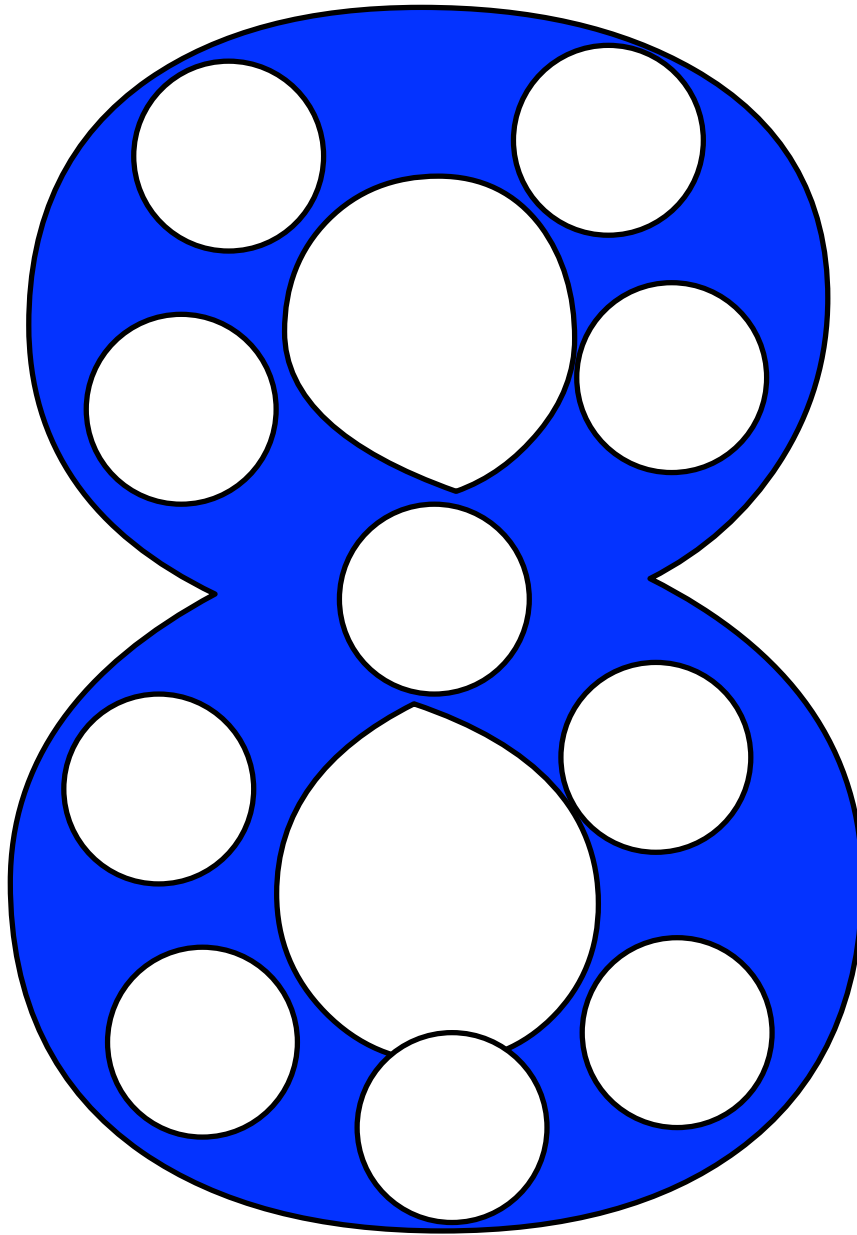
